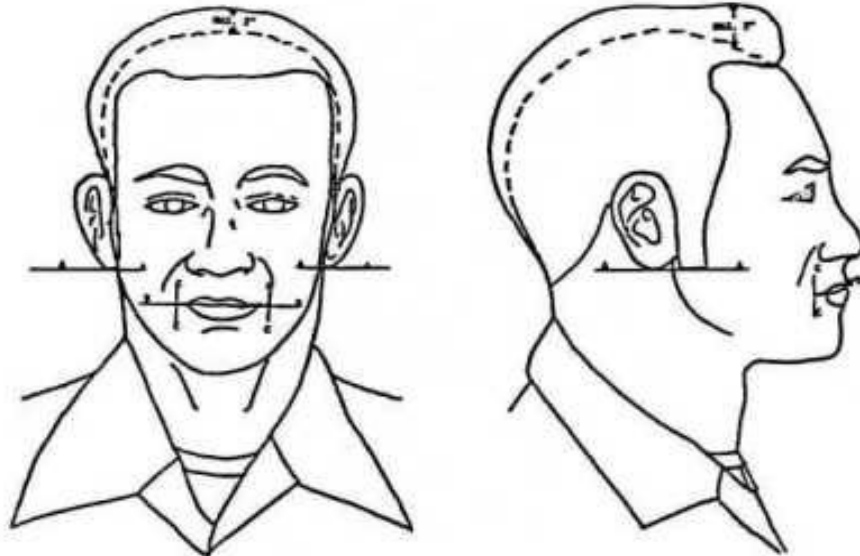

MALE GROOMING STANDARDS



(-- INDICATES SCALP LINE)

Sideburn shall not extend below the middle of the ear.

Sideburn must be even, not flared.

Sea Cadets are not authorized facial hair at any time.

Hairstyle properly groomed shall not be greater than 1.5 inches in bulk. Bulk is the distance that the mass of hair protrudes from the scalp.

No individual hair will measure more than 3 inches in length.

Hair must present a tapered appearance and shall not touch the ears or collar.

Multi-colored or faddish hair is not permitted. Hairstyle cannot interfere with the normal wear of military headgear. Certain cadets that elect membership in drill team, certain color guards or other special group may be required to have haircuts that exceed these standards.
